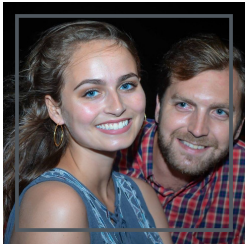


# MAGGIE'S LEARNING CENTER

### BANAN BASKETBALL

Zac coaches a co-ed basketball team at the local high-school in Banan. Our students will attend this high-school in the future.



### MLC PRESCHOOL

Each weekday morning, we lead a preschool for 30 students aged 4-6. We sing songs of worship and simple English learning songs, teach hygiene like brushing their teeth and washing their hands, pray with the students, and lead a learning activity.



### COMMUNITY ENGLISH CLASSES

After preschool, Logen teaches an English class open to all ages and families. The number of students grows each day!

## NEWS FROM MAGGIE'S SCHOOL...

It's been a tough but fulfilling year for Maggie's School Kenya. Turkana was hit with a major drought leaving the students and their families desperate. Maggie's School has become a crucial provider of food and supplies for the area. We had our first graduating class this year of students starting at Maggie's School in Kindergarten! Through your support, four of our top students have been sponsored to attend high-school (three boys and one girl). This is the first time these students have had a toothbrush, a mattress, or more than one pair of shoes. Also, eight months ago, all of our students were measured and new uniforms were made. Since then, conflict has escalated into a humanitarian crisis in the Turkana region, putting our kids and their families at risk. Please pray for peace and reconciliation for the area. The Kenyan government is working to resolve this conflict and penalize those responsible. *"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God," (Matthew 5:9 ESV).*



## ONE SCHOOL AT A TIME

### FOOD DELIVERIES

A major drought hit the Turkana region this year, leaving many of our students and their families without enough food. We sent funds to purchase extra bags of food to give to the community. The drought is so bad, that many families are in desperate need of food. Maggie's School continues to send resources to provide food for the community at large.



### NEW UNIFORMS

Our students have received new uniforms! We will ensure that new students receive them as well. The students still wear Maggie's favorite color blue and the school color of Christ Church Episcopal School.



## MEET MR. JORAM

Introducing a great friend of Maggie's School, Mr. Joram. Mr. Joram is a missionary on staff full-time with YWAM (Youth With A Mission) Kenya in Nairobi. He is also the founder of Wildfire Ministry of Kenya (WMK).

It is a Christ-centered ministry which aims to equip and train the unreached Pokot community for a lifestyle of Christ-centered service. The ministry theme is: "To gather, grow and give". The ministry intends to teach more about who God is, His character, His nature, and His ways. Pokot is a neighboring county to Turkana, where Maggie's School is located. Mr. Joram has now coordinated multiple trips delivering food supplies during a major drought and overseeing the measuring and delivery of new uniforms for the entire school. We are truly blessed by his friendship and servant heart. Please continue to pray for Mr. Joram and his family as he continues to travel to Pokot and Turkana for ministry.
